

In the year 1867, if memory serves me, a poem by him in one of the Southern periodicals attracted my notice. It was a brief lyric, distinguished by a peculiar and scarcely definable quality of fancy, which affected the reader much as a loving observer of nature might be affected by the strange, golden remoteness of an October horizon. I wrote to the young poet, who was more than a decade my junior, some words of appreciation touching these verses; and he replied in a manner so cordial that thenceforth a correspondence was established between us, which, though with many interruptions, continued down to a period closely preceding his death. From the beginning I could not but place a high value upon his letters. Their quaintness of thought and phraseology seemed at first to indicate affectation,? an affectation of archaism; but soon I learned to under- derstand that this style was as natural to Lanier as 1 When Mr. Hayne printed some of these letters in the Critic in 1886, his delicacy of feeling led him to omit all those portions in which Mr. Lanier expressed admiration for Mr. Hayne s work. It seems fitting that these should now be restored, and the letters are accordingly printed here in their...
