

Besides the usual charges on account of the Civil Government, it will be remarked in the Financial Account of each year, that there are large payments on account of Ireland, the West Indies, the Caffre war, or some other contingency. Although reckoned as casual payments, they may almost be put down as disbursements of a regular kind; for no year is exempted from their visitation. That to which we have at present to direct our attention, is the cost of the Civil Government; and on this subject...
