

Two roof wards and thirteen additional balconies for the medical pavilions, A and B, were begun in November, and will furnish means for giving open-air treatment to all the patients in these pavilions. At Gouverneur and Harlem trees have been planted on all the streets about the hospital. Fourth--The School for Midwives, which was established in July of last year, has progressed very satisfactorily. Twenty-five midwives have been graduated from the school, after completing a six months course of thorough theoretical and practical instruction. The number of both pupils and patients is steadily increasing, and more room...
