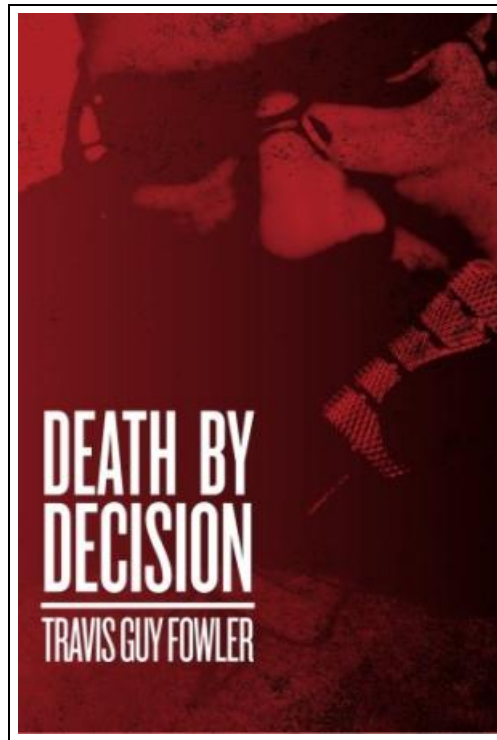

His murderous run begins to attract national attention, as law enforcement clings to newspaper articles that are the only commonality linking one decedent to the next, leading the FBI to descend upon the investigation. FBI profiler Jay Kraburn paints a dark picture of an elusive predator with an unquenchable thirst for blood whose killing spree will not stop until his own death or capture. With the stakes clearly defined, the investigation moves like a dust devil swirling out of control, as the beginning is confused with the end - and the in-between is as clear as a desert night without a moon.
