The Georgics are composed in total to 2500. Georgic The term comes from Greek and means worker of the earth. The work is divided into four books, which deal in order: crops and fields, arboriculture and vineyard, to herd livestock, and beekeeping. It can be seen that Virgil omits major themes such as gardens and botanical art; this is a voluntary oblivion, the author wanting to favor the business with pleasure.
