Then in those birds that fly very high or have to withstand the pressure of the air, you find in front of the macula, partly oovering the papillae of the nerve, an arrangement that looks like a spread hand, and which is supposed to be folded in front of the eye to protect it from too high pressure on the nerve, and if you take out this thing you find that it is the very finest osseous formation.
