



Interview with MAJ Bill Breeze, Part I

In this first of two interviews, Major Bill Breeze, from the California National Guard (NG), talks about commanding D Company, 1st Battalion, 140th Aviation in Bagram, Afghanistan from August 2003 through May 2004 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. He discusses taking command of a unit on paper only and constituting with elements from California and Arizona, all the challenges associated with mobilizing a specialized multi-state NG unit without equipment, the problem of handing off equipment between NG and Active Component units, and the maintenance issues presented by the unique environment of Afghanistan. He also talks about his company's famous unofficial donation-only Starbucks coffee operation, the challenge of splitting up deployment equipment amongst different state NG units, the need to let your soldiers run your organization, and the imperative of allowing NG units more than 30 days to mobilize and deploy. Breeze closes the interview by describing how his unit launched their own website so all of the soldiers' families could communicate. This item ships from La Vergne, TN. Paperback.
