




Government Operations: State Department Efforts to Improve Management of Overseas Real Property: T-Nsiad-91-40

Dimensions: 9.7in. x 7.4in. x 0.1in.GAO discussed the Department of States management of: (1) overseas real property; and (2) the Diplomatic Security Construction Program. GAO noted that: (1) continuing problems with States Office of Foreign Buildings Operations (FBO) included inadequate maintenance of overseas property and a lack of oversight and information systems to ensure efficient and effective use of resources at posts; (2) FBO oversight mechanisms did not fully address long-standing problems of noncompliance with established policies and standards in housing and other real estate programs; (3) FBO records indicated that only 15 percent of all overseas posts had been visited in the last 3 years, and 37 percent had been visited only once; (4) FBO is implementing two information systems to monitor post real estate programs more effectively, but until they are fully implemented, it remains unclear whether they will provide accurate data; (5) State has not developed any master plans that adequately link current programs with its long-range foreign policy plans; and (6) problems with the diplomatic security construction program included longrange planning, poor cost estimates, project cost increases and schedule delays, and insufficient...
