In his lonely world, he soon learned to follow the harsh law of the North - kill or be killed - and become a ferocious and magnificent creature. But nothing in his young life prepared him for the cruelty of the bully Beauty Smith, who buys *White Fang* from his Indian master and turns him into a vicious killer - a pit dog forced to fight for money. Much of the novel is written from the viewpoint *White Fang*, through whose experiences the author makes a parallel between the wilderness life among animals and the violent world of humans. Jack London (1876-1916), was an American author, journalist, and social activist. These two masterpieces, set during the 1890s Klondike Gold Rush, are based on the author's experiences as a gold prospector in the Canadian wilderness. Their great popularity...
