

When you're a fifth-generation descendant of the locally famous Maulhardt and Borchard families, history kind of comes with the territory. Not that Maulhardt minds. He's taught history for 25 years, currently of the eighth-grade variety at Frank Intermediate School in Oxnard. He's trying to preserve the two oldest structures on the Oxnard Plain via his ongoing Oxnard Historic Farm Park project. He's also the guy who in 2003 restaged an exhibition game played in Oxnard in 1913 between the New York Giants and Chicago White Sox that featured such Hall of Famers as Christy Mathewson and Tris Speaker (the subject of Maulhardt's first book, in 1997). His latest book, released last month and titled 'Conejo Valley,' shifts his history lens away from Oxnard, Port Hueneme and Camarillo and trains it a bit farther east. His next one will keep it there: Maulhardt is working on a book about Jungleland, the old animal amusement park in Thousand Oaks that closed in the 1970s. It's due out next year, and will make it an even dozen stops on history's local trail. 'I finish one and I feel a little burned out, and then something else comes along, the understated Maulhardt said by way of explaining his regular and prodigious output. 'There's some kind of connection in each of the books, so that's where the passion comes from.'
