In addition to filling normal Air Force and joint requirements, Air Force personnel are also filling traditional Army requirements. The strain of high operations tempo is being felt by all the services. Military personnel, to include the reserve components are pulling multiple tours in Iraq or Afghanistan, and the Air Force and the Army began to extend deployment tour lengths. To alleviate the aforementioned strain, the Air Force should utilize the approximate 174,000 Air Force civilians to help augment the forces. As the Air Force seeks to become a lighter, more agile force via transformation and recapitalization efforts, the requirement for forces has increased. Augmenting the active and air reserve component with Department of the Air Force civilians will provide a human resource solution in addition to realizing true total force integration as civilians and uniformed personnel perform together in a wartime environment. In February 2007, the Department of State asked the Department of Defense to assist in filling Provincial Reconstruction Teams (PRT) in Iraq and Afghanistan. The Secretary of Defense agreed to assist and tasked each service department to solicit civil servant volunteers to serve nine to twelve months temporary duty as a PRT member. The Air Force assisted the State Department with PRT requirements and was responsible for the training, equipping, and paying the salaries of the civilian volunteers. As such, the argument can be made that the Air Force has sufficient civilian manpower and money to support her own forces and requirements. 30 pp. Englisch.
