First of all I describe the procedure of collecting data and go into some essential basics. I will handle this in chapter two: Methodology. In chapter three I highlight meaning and origin of the element with information from dictionaries. Chapter four is about the different properties of pseudo-. The subparagraph 'morphological and syntactic properties' deals with the classification of morphemes according to Kortmann but also with the lexical category of the base and with the finding of particular suffixes. The phonological properties offer an analysis concerning syllables, stress pattern and pronunciation whereas the semantic properties is about pseudo- as an pejorative prefix.
