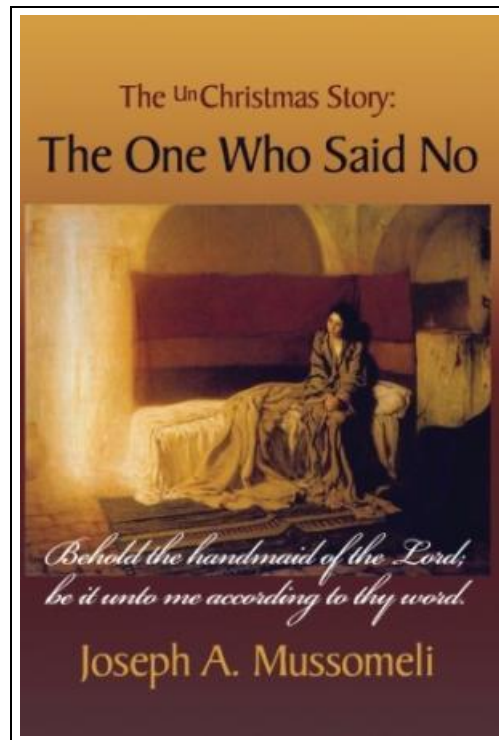

We understandably get so caught up in the excitement of the Nativity itself, we risk losing sight of the drama that must have unfolded earlier. The singing angels, the joyful shepherds, the mysterious wise men all unintentionally distract us from the dramatic prequel surrounding the miraculous conception. When Mary is asked by the Angel Gabriel to give birth to Jesus she is momentarily startled, but then unequivocally accepts the offer. Could it really have been so easy? Was she fully aware of all the consequences of her acceptance? What would have gone through her mind as she pondered the ramifications of her answer? The story as handed down to us stresses her faith in God and her determination to do as God asks. While this is meant to show the depth of Mary's trust and devotion, it also unintentionally diminishes her as a real person living in a particular time and place, confronted by a multitude of problems and fears. This story, set in Judea approximately 150 years before the birth of Jesus, seeks to explore some of the challenges and doubts that probably beset Mary as she struggled to accept God's offer. While Judith, the heroine of this story, ultimately rejects God's offer, the fears and temptations she wrestles with are likely the same ones that Mary confronted. She is made of real skin and bone, with blood and not just grace flowing through her veins. Mary, like Judith, must have been someone with deep fears and...
