




Women in Banking in the City of Minneapolis (Classic Reprint)

Every bank, but one, employing women in any capacity cooperated in giving the information requested between the period of July 1 to October 1, 1918. This included data in regard to name, address, wage, age, occupation, nationality, and marital condition of every woman employee, in addition to hours of work, sanitary conditions and replacement. The following banks having the largest number of employees cooperated by returning the schedules complete without the assistance of an investigator: Farmers Mechanics Savings Bank, Northwestern National Bank, First Security National Bank, Metropolitan National Bank, Minnesota Loan Trust...
