This matrix weathers brownish or yellowish owing to the oxidation of the iron present, while the phenocrysts of plagioclase become a dull greyish white, thus rendering the rock very conspicuous. In general the rock bears a very close megascopical resemblance to the diabase originally described as containing the Huronite while the phenocrysts themselves differ only in the degree of alteration they have undergone. The writer regards this diabase as the least altered representative of the series of rocks studied but which, under similar conditions, would have furnished a rock differing but slightly, if at all, from any of the more decomposed specimens first noticed and described as containing Huronite.
