More than half of his novels were part of a set of 20 collectively known as Les Rougon-Macquart. Set in Frances Second Empire, the series traces the hereditary influence of violence, alcoholism, and prostitution in two branches of a single family: the respectable (that is, legitimate) Rougons and the disreputable (illegitimate) Macquarts, for five generations. His works include Therese Raquin (1867), Germinal (1885), Abb Mourets Transgression (1886), The Three Cities, Part I (1894), The Three Cities, Part II (1896), The Three Cities, Part II (1894), The Second Empire (1905).
