Any opinions here expressed are not to be taken as official. I have the good fortune to live in one of those areas - forty-seven in number, outside the Metropolis - whose education authorities had realized that their powers to provide for the medical inspection of their schoolchildren involved an important public duty, and had acted accordingly, some years before the recent legislation rendering medical inspection compulsory from January 1st, 1908.
