

The duty which the scholar as a citizen owes to the state is one of the most frequent themes of the day; but the duties which we owe to society and the body politic as philologists and public teachers may also well engage for a moment our reflection at this beginning of our new year. We stand here as the representatives of one of those useless things which it is the true province of a university to teach. 
