There is abundant water in this valley, and the climate is equable, so that agriculture could have been carried on by the Indians with the greatest returns. Although the valuable farming land was limited the pueblos are, in the main, large and from various evidences were long inhabited. From Clifton, Ariz., along the San Francisco to a short distance above the mouth of the Blue there are a few ruins of the rectangular pueblo...
