

Galen used a curved probe-pointed knife with a single cutting edge. During the middle ages these radical methods were lost sight of. The prestige of the operative treatment was quickly restored when Felix successfully treated by incision a fistula on the person of Louis XIV. of France, employing the Bistouri Royale, a sickle-shaped knife. The ligature method was described by Hippocrates and again by Celsus. After the successful operation on Louis XIV. it was discarded, but again introduced by Desault. The credit of simplifying and bringing before the profession the modern operation of incision belongs to Pott, who discarded the complicated instruments used by the French and employed a moderately curved probe-pointed bistoury. After he had shown that extensive excision was not essential...
